Sub: Regarding submission of replies related to Intensive Examination Reports

The CTE, CVC while examining the case of Intensive Examination Report related to the work of Design, Supply, Installation, Testing & Commissioning of 305 Nos. full Bore Electromagnetic flow meters with GSM technology has observed that inspite of lapse of one year the reply to the paras (other than vigilance paras) of IE have yet not been received. In this context CVC has issued directions that henceforth, after submission of the IE report, if no reply is received in stipulated time, the paras which prima facie indicate of having vigilance angle will be put up to the Commission for treating the same as vigilance paras and action will be accordingly initiated against officials.

It is observed that the Divisions & C.E's treat the CTE paras casually and do not submit replies within stipulated/reasonable time.

Therefore, to avoid any unpleasant situation, it is necessary to review the status of reply furnished by Divisions to vigilance and update the list of replies wanting in CTE cases. A list to this effect needs to be prepared at Chief Engineer's level and forwarded to Vigilance Department within a fortnight's time so as to avoid any further embarrassment. I would request you to take proactive action in ensuring this in the time bound manner indicated. In addition, reply on above mentioned case be furnished in 48 hours which is required to be submitted to the Commission at the earliest.

This may be treated as Most Urgent.
