CIRCULAR


In pursuant to Circular no.11/09/11 dated 12.09.2011 of the CTE organization of the CVC, the following advisories may be given effect to -

1. While effecting recoveries from the contractor's running accounts bills, the same indicate that the effected recoveries are consequent to the observations of the Chief Technical Examiner Office (CTEO), in the case of intensive examination undertaken for the work by the CTEO.
2. In this connection, it may be noted that the contracts are primarily between the executing agency and the contractor. Any endorsements that the recoveries are being made at the instance of a third party could weaken the department's case during Arbitration or Court proceedings.
3. The observations/advice of the Commission is required to be considered by the executing agencies in terms of the contract and recoveries are to be imposed /enforced as admissible as per the conditions of the contract. The work executing divisions are advised that justification /reasons for recoveries in line with contract clauses should be recorded while

This issues with the approval of competent authority.


