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## **PRESS RELEASE**

Delhi Jal Board (DJB) has been conducting an intensive safety compliance drive across all construction and maintenance worksites since 24.01.2026 to ensure public safety. The drive is being implemented continuously, including Saturdays and Sundays.

The safety campaign is being carried out with the involvement of public representatives, who are being encouraged to share feedback and highlight unsafe conditions at worksites, enabling timely corrective action.

Further, in continuation of the ongoing drive, DJB has launched a three-day intensive safety enforcement campaign from 06.02.2026. To ensure enhanced monitoring and accountability, all Chief Engineers, Superintending Engineers and Executive Engineers have been directed to conduct on-ground inspections, ensure immediate rectification of deficiencies, and closely supervise compliance by tonight.

Intensive inspections of worksites and equipment are being carried out across several areas, including Karawal Nagar, Nand Nagar (Mandoli), Rohini, Ashok Vihar, PratapVihar, Kardampuri, Indraprastha Extension, Taimur Nagar, Burari, Nangloi, Dwarka, Wazirabad, HolambiKhurd, Rajouri Garden, Sultanpuri, Punjabi Bagh, ChandniChowk, Najafgarh, Vikas Nagar and Dilshad Garden.

DJB has adopted a zero-tolerance approach towards safety violations. Any lapse noticed at any level will attract strict action, and stringent measures will be taken against defaulting contractors, in addition to action against concerned officials, wherever applicable.

Delhi Jal Board reiterates its commitment to public safety and assures citizens that all necessary steps are being taken to maintain the highest standards of safety at all DJB worksites across Delhi.

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
