Grievance in this application is against vehicular congestion and environment pollution caused by the restaurants/ hotels/ motels/ banquets operating in Mahipalpur and Rajokri near Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi.</p> <p>2. The applicant claims to be a society of 170 residential farm houses at Rajokri, New Delhi. It is aggrieved by violation of environmental laws by respondent Nos. 13 to 30, which are commercial establishments operating as restaurants/ hotels/ motels/ banquets, along the National Highway No. 8 Expressway (Delhi-Jaipur), in the vicinity of the applicant society. Activities of the said establishments cause massive traffic congestion on account of unauthorized parking of vehicles</p>

	<p>Item No. 01</p> <p>November 02, 2018 A&R</p>	<p>and huge gatherings for weddings or other functions.</p> <p>3. Further grievance is that the above establishments discharge untreated waste. They do not have the requisite Effluent Treatment Plants (ETPs). Thus, they are creating pollution in the area, causing environmental degradation. In absence of waste management, there is foul smell, mosquito breeding, stagnant water accumulation, discharge of untreated sewage, ground water pollution etc. The establishments run huge diesel generators creating smoke and toxic gases thereby causing chronic ailments, affecting the health of the residents. The establishments are illegally extracting ground water. They are violating the Master Plan of Delhi. They are operating without environmental clearance and consents/ approvals under Water Cess Act, 1977, Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Municipal Solid Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2000. They do not have the requisite certificates/sanctioned plans from the Municipal Corporation, Police Department, Health Department, Fire Service Department, Pollution Control Committee, Airport Authority, Electricity Authority, Delhi Jal Board, Central Ground Water Board and Excise Department etc.</p> <p>4. The water table being critically low in the area, the extraction of ground water is not permissible. They do not have proper rain water harvesting and ground water recharge system. Noise pollution on account of bursting of crackers during such festivities is also a source of nuisance besides causing noise and air pollution. The</p>
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	<p>Item No. 01</p> <p>November 02, 2018 A&R</p>	<p>applicant suggests that a Committee should be constituted to study the effect and to suggest short term and long term measures for remediation and mitigation.</p> <p>5. The CGWA, vide public notice dated 18.05.2018, declared South and South West Districts of Delhi as critical and notified areas. The Lieutenant Governor of Delhi, vide order dated 18.05.2018, prohibited drawing of ground water by borewells/tube wells without permission of the Delhi Jal Board. Illegal drawing of ground water affects the ground water level. The applicants have filed photographs showing huge congestion outside the establishments of the respondents. They have also filed a private environment study report, prepared by an expert, in respect of area in question. The said Expert measured air quality, noise level, traffic congestion, impact of waste generation and concluded as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is high level of PM₁₀, PM_{2.5} & NO_x concentration in the ambient air. During winter season concentration of air pollutants would also get increased due the inversion condition in the atmosphere. • There is high ambient noise level. • There is problem of heavy traffic congestion on the service road of NH-8 (going towards Gurgaon, Haryana). Problem gets aggravated during massive social gathering (as reported) during marriage function and other party organized in the Banquette Garden/Hall located in the nearby vicinity. • There may be chances of contamination of Soil and Ground Water due to haphazard management of hazardous waste (Waste/Used oil generated from DG sets), liquid waste (effluent and sewage generated from the commercial activities like restaurants, banquet Garden/Hall, residential colonies etc.) and solid waste from (restaurants, banquet Garden/Hall residential colonies etc.)."
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	<p>Item No. 01</p> <p>November 02, 2018 A&R</p>	<p>6. Replies have been filed by the respondents. Reference may be made to the same in brief. Respondent No. 3, CGWB states that checking of violations, sealing of illegal wells and launching of prosecution is the responsibility of the Deputy Commissioner. The CGWB has not granted any NOC to any of the said respondents for ground water extraction prior to Notification dated 18.05.2018 issued by the Lieutenant Governor, constituting DJB and NDMC as Authorities to regulate ground water.</p> <p>7. The DCP (Traffic) has stated that the NH-8 is busiest highway of the country. Hotels, resorts and farm houses adjacent to NH-8, which host marriages, cause huge congestion. In peak marriage seasons, situation gets worst due to over-crowded vehicular movement of invitees. The DCP wrote to the concerned Authorities against the traffic menace. Details of prosecution launched for improper parking, drunken driving and entries in 'no entry' zones during marriage season have been given. The DCP Western Zone has also filed affidavits of similar effect. The Assistant Commissioner of Police (Licensing), in his reply, has referred to Notification dated 16.06.1995, issued by the DDA, requiring minimum width (right of way) of 30 meters and availability of service roads, as condition for permitting hotels at National Highways and Inter-State roads. Guidelines have been revised on 04.03.2002 and thereafter on 16.09.2013, by way of Table 5.4 to the Master Plan of Delhi - 2021. The Guidelines require leaving of right of way of 30 meters from national highway for hotels. Hotels are not permitted in green belt,</p>

Guest houses are allowed in residential area as per Notification dated 07.02.2007. The Delhi Police has given lodging licenses to Respondent Nos. 14, 15, 18, 21, 23, 24, 27, 28 and 29. No license has been given to Respondent nos. 13, 16, 17, 19, 20, 22, 25, 26 and 30. Table 5.4 referred to above, <i>inter-alia</i>, provides that a motel shall face road of minimum 30 meters right-of-way (ROW). If additional land is required for road widening to that extent, it has to be reserved out of the motel area.</p> <p>8. Stand of Respondent No. 9, a private respondent, is that it has sanction from the Municipal Corporation of Delhi. Deviations have been rectified and occupancy certificate given. Fire safety certificate has been given. Health trade license has been given CGWA has issued the necessary certificate. Electricity connection has been given. Excise Department is collecting tax. No items of environmental degradation are not caused by the said respondents. Respondent No. 18 has relied upon consent from DPCC, health trade license certificate from Municipal Corporation Delhi, license from Delhi Police and fire safety certificate. Respondent No. 7, another private respondent, has stated that the applicant society has filed the application in order to blackmail the said respondent. Respondent No. 27 claims that it has parking space for more than 500 cars. It is not discharging untreated waste water. It has installed ETP. It is not causing pollution, including noise pollution, it is not extracting ground water. Environment report replied upon by the applicant is a self-serving document. Respondent No. 15, another</p>

It is denied that it is causing any air or water pollution. It has ETP plant, approval from DJB for the extraction of ground water, Health trade license. Electricity connection, Consent from DPCC, Fire safety certificate, Certificate of registration etc. By and large, similar is the stand of other private respondents, including Respondent Nos. 14, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 30. Detailed reference to individual affidavits is not necessary, to avoid repetition.</p> <p>9. The South Delhi Municipal Corporation has given its comments about 16 out of 18 of the private respondents. Remaining two are said to have been closed. In respect of respondent No. 13, it is stated that it falls in unauthorized colony. Construction is unauthorized in violation of Section 343 and 344 of Delhi Municipal Corporation Act, 1957. Construction being prior to 01.06.2014, no action is taken. In respect of respondent No. 14, it is stated that property is being used for marriage/social functions by erecting temporary steel structures/tents in open space, without permission for organizing such functions. Similar is the stand with regard to respondent Nos. 15 and 16. In respect of respondent No. 16, it is stated that demolition action has been taken. In respect of respondent No. 16, it is stated that the property has been sealed under Section 345- A of the Delhi Municipal Corporation Act, 1957.</p> <p>10. In respect of most of other private respondents, it is stated that they do not have any permission for organizing marriage/ social functions by erecting temporary steel structures in open space and action is being taken for</p>

The DJB has filed its inspection report with regard to source of water, disposal of sewerage system and rain water harvesting system. In most of the cases, source of water supply is said to be the borewells.</p> <p>12. With regard to sewage connection, it is stated that there is no sewage connection but disposal is by STP in respect of some of them and without STP with regard to Nikunj (Managed by GNH Hotel & Resorts) 22nd Mile stone, NH-8, Near Shiv Murti, Rajokari; Green Villa Nitish Kunj Hotel Complex, Gate No. 2, NH-8, Samalkha, Umrao Hotel & Resorts NH-08, Samalkha; Forests Sheraton, Plot No. 9, NH-08, Samalkha; Flaan Hotel, Samalkha IGI, Airport; The Roseate (Earlier Lal Bar dusit Devarana), 21st Milestone, Samalkha IGI Airport; Green Garden, NH-08, Mahipalpur, Rangpuri, Near Shiv Murti; Arawali villa, FH 1, NH-08, Rajokari and Hotel Westend Inn, Near Shiv Murti, NH-08, Rangpuri. Thus, for the said nine of the respondents, there is neither sewage connection nor disposal through STP.</p> <p>13. The Delhi Government and the Delhi Pollution Control Committee have stated that closure order has been passed against respondent No. 13, Hotel Westend Inn, NH-08, Near Shiv Murti, Rangpuri; respondent No. 17, Aravali Villa, FH-01, NH-08, Rajokari; respondent No. 19, Green Garden, NH-08, Near Shiv Murti, Rangpuri, Mahipalpur; respondent No. 22 & 24, Mynt Bar & Lounge, 21st Milestone Complex/KOS Minar, Samalkha, Delhi-Jaipur Highway, NH-08; respondent No. 23, Udman</p>
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<p>Item No. 01</p> <p>November 02, 2018 A&R</p>	<p>Ramada, NH-08, Adjacent Shiv Murti, Rangpuri, Mahipalpur for not having consent to operate and a bond to pay environment compensation of Rs. 2 lakhs has been taken. In respect of respondent No. 30, it is stated that it had no permission for the borewell nor MCD/Delhi Police license. Discharge of effluent was into the septic tank and closure order was passed. Some of the respondents have filed additional affidavits in respect of the observations in the earlier inspection report.</p> <p>14. The SDMC has filed a status report on 03.04.2018 covering 16 private respondents, all of whom are said to be violating Section 345 of the Delhi Municipal Corporation Act, 1957, by raising unauthorized constructions or unauthorized user. Status report has also been filed in respect of two of the entities to whom fresh notices have been issued on the direction of Monitoring Committee constituted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. It is stated that apart from 16 respondents against whom action has been taken, two have been closed. This shows that all the eighteen respondents were operating in violation of law.</p> <p>15. We have heard learned counsel for the parties at length and perused the record, to which our attention has been drawn by learned counsel.</p> <p>16. Main reliance by learned counsel for the applicant is on status report filed by the SDMC, showing unauthorized constructions and user by all the commercial establishments who are the private respondents herein. In organizing marriages and other functions, without any</p>
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	<p>Item No. 01</p> <p>November 02, 2018 A&R</p>	<p>permission, they are acting in violation of law, as admitted by the South Delhi Municipal Corporation. Apart from the said stand, in the status report, reference is also made to the stand of the DJB that the ground water is being illegally extracted. Most of the private respondents do not have any proper waste disposal system. Further stand is that requisite right of way (ROW) of 30 meters from the Highway is not being maintained, which is a mandatory requirement of the Master Plan for permitting the activities of the said entities, though some of the private respondents have claimed that they are maintaining such distance. It is also stated that there are huge traffic jams on account of unauthorized parking during the marriage season, adding to the deteriorated air quality in Delhi. In these circumstances, learned counsel for the applicant suggests the need for prohibiting and or regulating the activities of marriage palaces, described as such or the restaurants, motels, banquet halls or other places used for huge gatherings of this nature, though not described as marriage palaces.</p> <p>17. Learned counsel for the official and the private respondents have stated that irrespective of justification for the activities of the private respondents, the members of the applicant society are themselves violating environment norms. They are having swimming pools for which they have illegally dug borewells in violation of norms for use of the ground water. Groundwater in notified area cannot be drawn without valid authorization. Such authorization can be given only for the purposes of drinking water, where municipal supply is not available.</p>
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	<p>Item No. 01</p> <p>November 02, 2018 A&R</p>	<p>Authorizations are conditional requiring recharge of ground water, which condition is not being met. In this connection guidelines issued by the CGWA have been referred to. It is also submitted that the farm houses also do not comply with the environment norms such as compliance with solid waste management rules. Farm houses are also being used for marriages or other functions. They also create noise and do not have adequate waste disposal systems.</p> <p>18. We do find from the material on record that there is clear violation of environment law by most of the private respondents. SDMC has found their working to be illegal. Even after this stand of the SDMC, it is not clear why they are being allowed to continue, if they are illegal. Such violations must be dealt with in accordance with law. Learned Counsel for the Private respondents submitted that similar violations are taking place by similar entities not only throughout Delhi but Pan India and even by the Members of the Applicant society. The directions of this Tribunal, thus, should cover all similarly placed persons.</p> <p>19. Violations to be dealt with can be summed up as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) unauthorized constructions in violation of Delhi Municipal Act, 1957 and the Master Plan of Delhi. (ii) Noise Pollution in violation of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules, 2000. (iii) Violation of Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.
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	<p>Item No. 01</p> <p>November 02, 2018 A&R</p>	<p>(iv) Violation of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 in disposal of Sewage waste.</p> <p>(v) Extraction of ground water in violation of CGWA guidelines, 2012</p> <p>(vi) Absence of water harvesting system in violation of Municipal Bye Laws, 2011 as well as CGWA guidelines requiring mandatory water harvesting for ground water recharge, as a condition for drawl of ground water.</p> <p>(vii) Violation of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981</p> <p>(viii) Violation of principle of sustainable development, which may require carrying capacity assessment or adherence to laid down or inherently necessary norms for protection of Environment.</p> <p>We may discuss the same seriatim.</p> <p>20. Re: (i) Unauthorized constructions in violation of Delhi Municipal Corporation Act 1957 and the Master Plan of Delhi.</p> <p>As per stand of the South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SDMC) and the status report dated 03.04.2018 filed by it, it is clear that all the 16 private respondents have raised unauthorized construction or are engaged in unauthorized user for the purpose of operating banquets etc. for organizing wedding and other functions, by erecting temporary construction in open space. It appears that only on account of the present proceedings some action has been taken by SDMC and the action is limited to persons impleaded to this proceeding. It is matter of</p>
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	<p>Item No. 01</p> <p>November 02, 2018 A&R</p>	<p>common knowledge that there are large number of persons or other legal entities engaged in organizing marriages or other functions in the similar fashion by erecting temporary structures or tents in open spaces or by raising unauthorized construction. Action taken by SDMC in Delhi does not match the demand for enforcement of law. This Tribunal in <i>Society for Protection of Culture, Heritage, Environment, Traditions and Promotion of National Awareness Vs. National Highway Authority of India & Ors.</i>¹ vide order dated 03.10.2018 dealt with the issue de-clogging the traffic from National Highways and directed that there should not be any kind of illegal encroachments on the National Highways by dhabas/restaurants, entrance of any building should not directly open up on National Highway/State Highway, the opening should only be through by-lanes and there shall no construction of any kind in the specified area for green cover along the Highway / Scheduled road or the Bypasses. The Municipal Corporations shall thus, to conduct appropriate survey and prepare and execute action plan for enforcement of law in time bound manner. Such action has to be a continuous exercise. This also requires periodical monitoring and audit at appropriate level.</p> <p>21. Re: (ii) Noise Pollution in violation of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules, 2000.</p> <p>The applicant has made a clear statement that the organizers of parties, functions, marriages in restaurants, hotels, motels, banquets use huge diesel generators. They</p>

It is well known DG sets and other instruments as also the crackers create noise pollution, in violation of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules, 2000. The menace of noise pollution has also been the subject matter of consideration by this Tribunal in several decisions inter-alia in <i>Hardeep Singh & Ors. vs. SDMC & Ors.</i>², in the context of such activities in the area of Rajouri Garden, Delhi, the matter was recently considered. Therein, reference was made to earlier order of Tribunal requiring drawing up of a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for controlling noise pollution and for banning of generator sets of 5 KVA and above specially, between 10 PM to 6 AM. Reference was also made to an order of the in High Court of Delhi in <i>Free Legal Aid Cell Vs. Government of NCT of Delhi</i>, AIR 2001 Delhi 455. Referring to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in <i>In Re: Noise Pollution- Implementation of the Laws for restricting use of loud speakers and high volume producing sound systems</i>³, it was observed that the menace of noise pollution seriously affected public health and was required to be checked as per rules. Certain areas are required to be declared and treated as silence zones. The noise level was required to be within prescribed norms, specially between 10PM and 6 AM, so as not to disturb the sleep and peace of people. The Tribunal also noticed the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court to educate students for ill effects of air and noise pollution. Accordingly, the Tribunal directed constitution of a Committee comprising of DCP nominated by</p>

Such Committee is required to review the situation at least once in a week and have dedicated helpline for 24X7, monitored jointly by DCP and SDM. Two senior citizens and suitable number of para-legal volunteers of the concerned area to be nominated by the Legal Services Authority, are to be associated. We are of the view, that to regulate noise level at banquets, hotels, motels or other places where functions are organized, noise meters should be installed at the boundary walls. It should be ensured that the noise level does not exceed the limit of 45 dB or such limit as is statutorily prescribed. DG sets should be noiseless and must comply with the emission norms. Only use of green crackers without any bombs or illuminating firework can be permitted upto maximum limit of 15 minutes at a convenient time which is not during 10 PM to 6 AM.</p> <p>22. Re:(iii) Violation of Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016</p> <p>This Tribunal has recently considered the compliance of provisions of Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 vide order dated 20.08.2018 in O.A. No. 606 of 2018. The Tribunal noticed that as per annual report published by CPCB there were serious deficiencies in compliance of the rules. Earlier orders of the Tribunal dated 22.12.2016 had not been complied. The Tribunal held that while prosecution and fixing of accountability for the failure may be different issues, there was immediate need for such compliance and monitoring thereof at appropriate levels.</p>

The Tribunal also noticed that even the proposed plans did not cover the entire waste generated nor the plans had taken into account the incremental growth in future. There were no plans for forests and hilly terrains where the waste was simply burnt or thrown on the hill slopes. Accordingly, the Tribunal directed constitution of Committees to over see the compliance of law and orders of the Tribunal and also directed conduct of performance audits to fix responsibility. The Tribunal also directed adoption of best practices, such as setting up of control rooms where citizens can upload photos, to be looked into by accountable persons, use of CCTV cameras, GPS system in garbage collection vans. Cinquets, hotels, restaurants and other such places must comply with all the rules and to separate, store and process the waste and must have for this purpose their own decentralized waste processing facilities.

23. Re:(iv) Violation of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 in disposal of Sewage waste.

Inspection report of the BJB points out that there is no sewage connection in the establishments of any of the private respondents. Some of them have not even installed STPs. In view of Section 25 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, sewage is not allowed to be discharged in stream or well or on land and for discharge of sewage prior consent of the State Board is necessary. Section 24 also deals with restrictions on disposal of any polluting matter in stream or well or land. Violation of the said provisions may not only result in closure of such activity but also lead to prosecution

In spite of report to the effect that in the present case sewage is not being legally discharged, no action has been taken by the DPCC for which persons responsible must be dealt with in accordance with law. Requisite action may now be taken forthwith, including more cautions. Every banquet or such other establishment must have pre-sewage Treatment Facility/Plant (PSTP) as condition for its working.</p> <p>24. Re: (v) Extraction of ground water in violation of CGWA guidelines, 2012</p> <p>Even though the CGWA had disown responsibility for taking action for violation, the fact remains that no prior permission has been taken by any of the private respondents either from the CGWA or from the DJB/Municipal Corporation who are said to be authorized institutions in terms of the notification issued by the LG. As per inspection report of the DJB, borewells are installed by all the private respondents. According to the private respondents, borewells are also installed by the members of the applicant society in their respective farmhouses at Rajokri, New Delhi.</p> <p>CGWA has been constituted under the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court M.C. Mehta Vs. Union of India, (1997) 11 SCC 312. The said authority has laid down guidelines in the year 2012, categorizing the areas depending upon the hydro-geological conditions. Fresh draft of guidelines has been issued on 16.11.2015 to the effect that there are 1071 over-exploited, 2174 critical and</p>
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		<p>697 semi -critical units. In such areas, ground water can be drawn for drinking and domestic purpose only. Such drawal can be permitted if there is no water supply or if the under ground water is contaminated. Drawal of the ground water is subject to mandatorily requirement of recharge of the ground water. Recharge is required equal to the drawal or more depending upon the area.</p> <p>The matter has been subject matter of several orders of this Tribunal, including in order dated 28.08.2018 in <i>Shailesh Singh Vs. Hotel Holiday Regency, Moradabad & Ors.</i> ⁴ In the said order, the Ministry of Water Resources in consultation with MoEF and Ministry of Agriculture has reviewed the existing mechanism for conserving ground water in over-exploited, critical and semi-critical areas. This Tribunal also prohibited drawal of ground water by industrial units for commercial purposes. Thus, borewells dug by banquetstetc. as well as by farm houses including those or the members of the applicant society are required to be sealed, on ascertaining availability of permission from concerned authority and compliance of conditions of recharge and use of water being for domestic or drinking purpose. If ground water is used through tubewells for swimming pools in violation of law, Supply of such swimming pools from the tubewells must be forthwith stopped. It is further made clear that re-use of water, after being disinfected as per norms, can be used for swimming pools and such water thereafter may be used for flushing, by installing double piping system, or utilized for plantation or gardening.</p>

25. Re: (vi) **Absence of water harvesting system in violation of Municipal Bye Laws, 2011 as well as CGWA guidelines requiring mandatory water harvesting for ground water recharge, as a mandatory condition for drawl of ground water.**

In view of non-availability of potable drinking water for large section of the society, there is dire need for water harvesting system to be made compulsory. Normally such condition is incorporated while giving approval to every building. This Tribunal dealt with the issue in its order dated 30.08.2018 in O.A No. 496 of 2016, Tribunal on its own motion vs NCT. The stand of the DJE was noted that, the demand for potable water in Delhi was being met from surface to the extent of 820 million gallons and 80 million gallons from ground water sources. Surface water as well as ground water are over stressed requiring comprehensive water management plan for rain water harvesting system as well as for use of treated water for ground water recharge. CGWA has prepared a plan for artificial recharge of ground water as well as revival and rejuvenation of water bodies through roof top to rain water harvesting system which is required for plot of 100 sq. meters or more under the Bylaws dated 28.07.2001. This Tribunal found that even though the plan has been prepared, its implementation on the ground remained a challenge. The Tribunal, accordingly, appointed an Oversight Committee to monitor such compliance, headed

		<p>by a former Judge of Delhi High Court.</p> <p>In order dated 25.10.2018, in <i>Mrs. Sunita Pandey & Anr. Vs. Union of India & Ors.</i>⁵, the Tribunal considered the issue of acute shortage of potable water on account of arsenic contamination in Balia. The Tribunal referred to Niti Agyog report to the effect that 70 per cent of the water is contaminated in India. In water quality index, India is at 120th place out of 122 countries. About 2 lac people die every year. This required effective water management. Water being necessity of life and need of potable water being fundamental right, the matter has to be taken seriously, not only in Delhi but in all States where there is shortage of potable water. As far as Delhi is concerned, we request the Committee already constituted in terms of order dated 30.08.2018 to look into this aspect in the context of water harvesting requirement, public gatherings in every establishment of hotels, motels, banquet and other places where public gathering are organized. It is utmost essential that such roof top harvesting or recharge of ground water takes place and compliance of this direction is overseen by the concerned authorities.</p> <p>26. Re: (vii) violation of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981</p> <p>We have already noted the allegations and it is also self evident that use of DG sets and fire crackers creates smoke and toxic gases and adds to the deterioration of air quality. Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 provides for consent to operate for every</p>

		<p>industrial/commercial activity covered by Section 21 of the said Act. Section 22 prohibits emissions beyond laid down standards. Emission beyond prescribed standards can lead to closure of the activity under Section 31 A, apart from prosecution. Deterioration of air quality is a serious concern not only in Delhi but atleast in 102 cities in India where air quality has not been up to the prescribed standards in the last 5 years.</p> <p>Delhi is ranked as third in the cities, reporting most deaths due to air pollution as per some survey.⁶ Statutory mechanism under the Air Act has not been successful in controlling air pollution. The matter has been dealt with in Judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, referred in the said order of the Tribunal. Comprehensive action plan has been prepared for NCR which provides for Graded Response for Action Plan (GRAP). In GRAP, specific strategies to reduce number of vehicles, traffic movement, parking, control of open burning, control of air dust etc., are provided.</p> <p>We have already noted the stand of Delhi Police that NH-8 is the busiest highway. The situation becomes worse in marriage season due to overcrowded vehicle movement. Prosecution has been launched for parking in metal roads and entering no entry zone. Overcrowding becomes unmanageable on account of leaving the vehicles at service lanes. This is serious concern on account of non-availability of pathway for the pedestrians or for the cyclists. In the face of such material, the stand of the</p>

	<p>private respondents that no air pollution is caused is hardly acceptable. There is dire need not to permit activities, at the cost of air pollution. One such step is not to permit marriage halls in crowded areas, without availability of adequate parking space. Prohibiting parking on main roads, metaled roads and narrow roads and permitting parking only at authorized places is necessary. Organizing of social functions beyond the carrying capacity needs to be strictly regulated for protection of environment.</p> <p>Merriment the organizers of such functions cannot be at the cost of pollution, diseases and death. Learned counsels have also suggested during the hearing that there is need for mind set change to keep marriage and other similar events simple affair on voluntary basis, in the interest of health and welfare of fellow citizens, in the spirit of fundamental duties under Article 51 of the Constitution. The Indian society has for long been inspired by the noble thoughts of Mahatma Gandhi enshrined in the Bhajan "Vaishnava Jani Tu Tene Kahiya Je Peed Parayi Jane Re" (Good person is he who appreciates the pain of others). It is time these sentiments are put to use to arrive at pragmatic solutions to serious environmental concerns.</p> <p>There has been debate on the subject at the highest level. The Prime Minister Lal Bhadur Shastri advised that there should be no exhibition of ostentation at weddings.</p>
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Control orders were issued for regulating such celebrations.⁸ Apart from good social policy, this is time to discourage huge gatherings for organizing marriages and other such events by law in view of the principle of sustainable development.

27. Re: (viii) Violation of other environmental laws for compliance of mandate of sustainable development.

Mandate of sustainable Development is statutorily laid down under section 20 of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010. This mandate is now integral part of Article 21 of the Constitution. Thus, *de-hors* any specific provision of law, the concept requires that any activity causing air, water or other pollution affecting health or others has to be prohibited and prevented. Giving effect to this Principle may require that polluting activities of hotels, motels, banquets at NH-8 expressway as well as any other establishment in already crowded places to be prohibited/regulated consistent with the principle of Sustainable Development.

28. We, thus, conclude that there is immediate need for prohibiting and regulating activities violating environmental laws, which may include action for not complying with Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016; Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016; illegal drawl of water, violation of Master Plan requiring leaving of right-of-way, regulatory measures for holding of functions in open without authorization, check against creation of noise pollution, illegal parking for which not only person

	<p>parking but also person organizing a function whose guest is doing illegal parking for attending such function may be liable to check such illegal traffic violation. Norms for extent of traffic to be permitted, to prevent pollution, are necessary. If such norms are not laid down, the same ought to be laid down after study of the carrying capacity of particular locations, as directed on <i>SPOKE Vs. M/s. Kasauli Glaxie Resort and other connected matters</i>⁹ and <i>Ajay Khara Vs. Container Corporation of India Limited & Ors.</i>¹⁰</p> <p>29. Environmental laws are required to be read into every activity adversely impacting environment. Grant of any permission or sanction by any authority has always to be read as subject to inherent limitation of the environment norms being maintained. Once pollution is being created, mere permission/sanction by itself is no defense. While absence of a sanction may by itself be violation of law, even grant of sanction is never to be treated as unconditional and does not obviate the requirement to maintain environment norms. Adverse impact on environment is actionable in all situations. Right to regulate and lay down environment norms is coupled with the duty and such norms must be laid down to the extent required. In absence of other specific provisions, over-arching power of Central Government under Section 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 can always be availed.</p> <p>30. As already noted, the principle of sustainable</p>

		<p>development is a part of 'Right to Life' under Article 21 of the Constitution of India. It is statutory guiding principle for exercise of jurisdiction under Sections 14 and 15 of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010 read with Section 20 thereof. The Tribunal can issue direction necessary for enforcement of such principles even <i>de hors</i> a statutory provision. This principle recognizes right of every citizen to healthy environment i.e. right to breathe fresh air, access to potable water and prohibiting any activity adversely affecting public health, including the noise pollution. Statutory mandate in, the form of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974; Delhi Municipal Corporation Act, 1957 has to be enforced in letter and spirit. This requires identification of accountable authorities to enforce such violations. Absence of desired implementation has led to massive environment degradation, without adequate penal action against the violators or authorities responsible for collusion or inaction. The number of deaths and diseases caused by violation of environmental laws are enormous, placing India high in the index of polluted countries. Air norms are not achieved in 102 cities and there are 351 polluted river stretches. Solid Waste Management Plans are not in place in large number of cities.</p> <p>31. Access to drinking water remains a challenge. There are critical areas in terms of depletion of groundwater without any adequate check on drawal of groundwater even in such areas. Rainwater harvesting is the dire need which is not being followed. Huge congestion of traffic not</p>
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only causes great inconvenience to commuters but also strains the air quality, resulting in diseases and deaths. These substantial questions of environment, attract the jurisdiction of this Tribunal under Sections 14 & 15 of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010 for relief to the victims and the environment.

32. We have already noted that the pleadings referred to above do show absence of system of sewage disposal, extraction of groundwater for commercial purposes in critical area, absence of rainwater harvesting system which is mandatory in such area, absence of ground water recharge, deficient air quality on account of excessive traffic congestion, use of DG Sets, absence of proper municipal solid waste management and the noise pollution.

33. We, accordingly, direct the authorities responsible to take immediate steps to comply with above directions and to stop activities contributing to the pollution by the private respondents or other similar persons by preparing an action plan within one month from the date of receipt of this order and latest by 31.12.2015. This may be done by a Joint Committee with the representatives of concerned Municipal Corporation, Central Ground Water Authority, Delhi Jal Board, Delhi Police and the Delhi Pollution Control Committee. Such Joint Committee may be headed by the Secretary, Urban Development, Govt. of NCT Delhi. The Joint Committee must meet at least twice in a month. In its first meeting, it must prepare the action plan and lay down timelines for enforcement in NCT Delhi especially with regard to system of sewage disposal,

		<p>extraction of groundwater for commercial purposes in critical areas without any replenishment, absence of rainwater harvesting system which is mandatory in such areas, absence of ground water recharge, degraded air quality on account of excessive traffic congestions and use of DJ Sets, absence of proper municipal solid waste management and noise pollution. In other words, following aspects will be addressed by the Joint Committee:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) Compilation of data of all such places where marriages and functions take place which should be published and appropriately regulated. ii) Regulate noise level at above places as per laid down norms. This includes regulation of DJ sets, loudspeakers and crackers etc. iii) Compliance of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, and sewage discharge including decentralized waste processing facilities, installation of CCTV camera, GPS system in garbage collection vans etc. iv) Regulation of extraction of groundwater as per applicable guidelines, sealing of tubewells including those installed for swimming pools in violation of law, need for reuse of water for flushing, Plantation or gardening. v) Rain Water Harvesting by installing roof top harvesting systems. vi) Regulating size of gatherings on the concept of sustainable development in the light of carrying capacity of the area.
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		<p>vii) Prohibiting such activities in overcrowded places not having adequate parking or other facilities.</p> <p>viii) action against unauthorized construction or unauthorized use without statutory clearances prohibiting and stopping any existing or future activities non-complying with above norms and also taking penal action where ever necessary.</p> <p>xi) Environment restoration and compensating victims of violation of law in relation to Noise Pollution, Air Pollution, Water Pollution, Master Plan etc.</p> <p>The action plan must involve all stakeholders, particularly the students and senior citizens. The Joint Committee will have authority to close polluting activity and remove every illegal structure. The Committee will also look into the allegations whether members of the applicant are running swimming pools by illegally drawing groundwater without requisite valid sanctions and drawal of ground water from critical or over-exploited areas, without any mechanism for ground water harvesting and recharge. If so, remedial action must be taken forthwith.</p> <p>34. Learned Counsel for the official respondents suggest that since interpretation of law may be required, a person of judicial background may need to act as oversight mechanism to oversee the working of the Joint Committee from time to time.</p> <p>35. On suggestion of the learned counsel appearing for the parties, we appoint Justice S. P. Garg, former Judge, High Court of Delhi to discharge such functions. We note</p>
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that Justice S. P. Garg is already heading a Committee appointed by this Tribunal with regard to the issue of rainwater harvesting, which is also one of the issues involved in this case. We request him to oversee the activities of the Joint Committee constituted above.

36. The Chief Secretary, Delhi will provide all requisite logistic support and Assistance, for functioning of the Oversight Committee. Facilities, if any, already provided may also be used for this purpose.

37. Liberty to enjoy celebrations is welcome but not without any responsibility or accountability for protection of peace and comfort of others. If enjoyment by creating noise pollution, air pollution, water pollution, obstructing free flow of traffic irreversibly damages our limited natural resources in violation of law, such enjoyment has to be checked. Avoiding wasteful expenditure, adversely affecting the health and welfare of fellow citizens, is against the spirit of Fundamental Duties under the Article-51A of the Constitution of India. Enjoyment of few at the cost of happiness of others is not the culture of this country nor consistent with the constitutional values.

38. The Oversight Committee may submit a report of compliance every three months. First such report may be furnished before the next date. A copy thereof be also sent to CPCB and MoEF & CC.

39. After the receipt of report by this Tribunal, in the light of the findings, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change and the Central Pollution Control Board may consider drawing up an action plan and

ORDER

1. The issue for consideration is the compliance of order of this Tribunal dated 02.11.2018 for enforcement of environmental norms by restaurants/ hotels/ motels/ banquets operating in Mahipalpur and Rajokri near Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi and also by similar establishments elsewhere.

2. Vide order dated 2.11.2018, this Tribunal considered the issue of violation of the environmental norms, including absence of waste management, discharge of untreated sewage, illegal ground water extraction, ground water contamination, emissions by illegally operating diesel generators, absence of statutory clearance under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and compliance with the conditions for grant of such clearances, where such clearances have been granted. Issues of absence of rain water harvesting and ground water recharge system, excess noise pollution by bursting of crackers etc. were also considered.

3. The stand of the Municipal Corporation and other official respondents was that the establishments in question did not have permission for organizing social functions by erecting temporary steel structures in open space. Source of water supply was borewells without valid sanction. There was no proper sewage connection in most of the establishments. Closure orders were passed against some of the establishments for not having consent to operate. Right of way from the highways had not been maintained, which was a mandatory requirement under the master plan. Huge traffic jams could be seen at these locations. Unauthorized parking on public places obstructed the traffic and caused huge air pollution. Swimming pools were being operated with the borewells using ground water without any valid authorization.

4. The Tribunal considered the matter under the following heads:

(i) Unauthorized constructions in violation of Delhi Municipal Act, 1957 and the Master Plan of Delhi.

(ii) Noise Pollution in violation of Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules, 2000.

(iii) Violation of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.

(iv) Violation of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 by unscientific disposal of Sewage waste.

(v) Violation of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016.

(vi) Extraction of ground water in violation of Central Ground Water Authority guidelines, 2012.

(vii) Absence of water harvesting system in violation of Municipal Bye Laws, 2011 as well as CGWA guidelines requiring mandatory water harvesting for ground water recharge, as a condition for drawal of ground water.

(viii) Violation of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution Act, 1981

(ix) Violation of principle of sustainable development, which requires carrying capacity assessment or

adherence to laid down or inherently necessary norms for protection of Environment.

5. Under each head it was found that there were violations. There was inaction of authorities in enforcing the law when violations are patent. There was need for clear policy and enforcement in the interest of public health by following the 'Precautionary Principle'.
6. The Tribunal observed that Delhi ranked as 3rd reporting most deaths due to air pollution as per some studies¹. In absence of proper regulation, overcrowding was unmanageable. Parking on roads obstructed the traffic. Marriage halls were being permitted without having adequate parking space. There was non-compliance of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, illegal drawal of ground water, violation of Master Plan requiring leaving of right-of-way on the side of the Highways. Regulatory measures for holding of functions in open were not being followed. Noise pollution was unchecked. Not only person parking but also the person organizing a function should be made responsible for illegal parking. Person inviting large number of guests must be required to ensure that parking is available, to avoid inconvenience to public. Norms for extent of traffic to be permitted to prevent pollution are necessary².

7. Finally, the Tribunal directed as follows:

"We, accordingly, direct the authorities responsible to take immediate steps to comply with above directions and to stop activities contributing to the pollution by the private respondents or other similar persons by preparing an action plan within one month from the date of receipt of this order and latest by 31.12.2018. This may be done by a Joint Committee with the representative of concerned Municipal Corporation, Central Ground Water Authority, Delhi Jal Board, Delhi Police and the Delhi Pollution Control Committee. Such Joint Committee may be headed by the Secretary, Urban Development, Govt. of NCT Delhi. The Joint Committee must meet at least twice in a month. At its first meeting, it must prepare the action plan and lay down timelines for enforcement in North Delhi especially with regard to system of sewage disposal, extraction of groundwater for commercial purposes in critical areas without any replenishment, absence of rainwater harvesting system which is mandatory in such areas, absence of ground water recharge, degraded air quality on account of excessive traffic congestions and use of DJ Sets, absence of proper municipal solid waste management and noise pollution. In other words,

following aspects will be addressed by the Joint Committee:

- (i) Compilation of data of all such places where marriages and functions take place which should be published and appropriately regulated.*
- (ii) Regulate noise level at above places or per laid down norms. This includes regulation of DJ sets, loudspeakers and crackers etc.*
- (iii) Compliance of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, and sewage discharge including decentralized waste processing facilities, installation of CCTV camera, GPS system in garbage collection vans etc.*
- (iv) Regulation of extraction of groundwater as per applicable guidelines, sealing of tube wells including those installed for swimming pools in violation of law, need for reuse of water for flushing, Plantation or gardening.*
- (v) Rain Water Harvesting by installing roof top harvesting systems.*
- (vi) Regulating size of gatherings on the concept of sustainable development in the light of carrying capacity of the area.*
- (vii) Prohibiting such activities in overcrowded places not having adequate parking or other facilities.*

(viii) action against unauthorized construction or unauthorized use without statutory clearances prohibiting and stopping any existing or future activities non-complying with above norms and also taking penal action where ever necessary.

(ix) Environment restoration and compensating victims of violation of law in relation to Noise Pollution, Air Pollution, Water Pollution, Master Plan etc. The action plan must involve stakeholders, particularly the students and senior citizens. The Joint Committee will have authority to close polluting activity and remove every illegal structure. The Committee will also look into the allegations whether members of the applicant are running swimming pools by illegally drawing groundwater without requisite valid sanctions and drawing of ground water from critical or over-explored areas, without any mechanism for ground water harvesting and recharge. If remedial action must be taken forthwith.

8. An Oversight Committee was also constituted to oversee the action taken in pursuance of above directions. Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF) was directed to draw up an action plan and guidelines applicable on pan India basis also.

9. A status report has been filed before this Tribunal on 07.03.2019 by the Delhi Government to the effect that similar matter was dealt with by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition (C) 4677/1985 M.C. Mehta Vs. Union of India & Ors. vide order dated 11.012.2018. A draft policy for holding social functions was prepared which has been perused by the monitoring Committee chaired by Dr. Bhure Lal in his capacity as head of EPCA and put in public domain for inviting objections. A joint Committee was formed on 18.2.2019 which held meetings on 20.02.2019 and 28.02.2019. Justice Garg Committee which was an oversight Committee has been informed.

10. The status report does not show any tangible steps in compliance of directions of this Tribunal. The Joint Committee is said to have been formed only on 20.02.2019, after more than three months of the order. In the two meetings, no tangible action has been taken for enforcement of the norms nor any action plan prepared to deal with various issues. Oversight Committee has simply been informed of constitution of joint committee and not the steps taken. Mere making of a draft policy providing that the rules be followed cannot be held to be sufficient for the enforcement of the order. There is, thus, non application of mind and failure on the part of Delhi Government in carrying out significant directions of this Tribunal required for protection of environment and public health. Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court is not the same as the order of the Tribunal which

requires several specific subjects. Mixing up the two appears to be to avoid execution which approach cannot be appreciated. The so called 'policy' does not cover all the steps necessary in terms of order of this Tribunal.

11. Make believe compliance cannot be taken as compliance. No meaningful action has been taken against the violators of law nor any verification or study has been carried out, as expected. The problem continues. Such apathy, to issues of environment protection which affect public health, by regulatory bodies is a matter of serious concern and has to be dealt with sternly.

In view of above, Delhi Government is required to furnish performance guarantee in the sum of Rs. 5 crores within one month, to the satisfaction of the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), which amount will be forfeited if the order of this Tribunal is not meaningfully complied with within next two months. The compliance report may be filed within two months. The compliance may be cross-checked by the Committee headed by Justice Garg. The report of Justice Garg may be made available within one month thereafter.

13. The statutory provisions and norms dealing with the matter are already available and have been referred to in the order dated 02.11.2018. Policy may be required only on matters not specifically covered by the statutes. There has to be a plan for execution of norms and provide for meaningful monitoring of actions for enforcing the norms of the Air Act, the Water Act, the

Environment (Protection) Act and Rules and regulations, including effective coercive measures with prompt timelines.

14. MoEF may also positively file its report before the next date, failing which Joint Secretary concerned may be named by the Secretary, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change as the person responsible for failure who may remain present in person and may be made accountable.

Let the matter be for further consideration on 08.07.2019.

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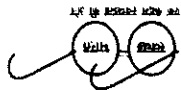
