INSTRUCTIONAL ORDER

To prevent water born diseases such as cholera, gastroenteritis, jaundice etc. following action is required to be taken by EEs/ZEs/JEs:

1. To survey all vulnerable points/locations for water born diseases.

2. To survey distribution water lines passing through drains/ sewer manholes and shift the same immediately.

3. To conduct a survey for tracing out domestic service lines passing through drains/sewer manholes and get it shifted immediately. Similarly all corroded/damaged service line should be identified and also replaced.

4. The water leakages from water mains/distributions mains should be identify

and attended/plugged on war footing.

5. Surcharged/blocked sewers are cause for contamination. Therefore, it should be ensured to desilt sewers, remove blockage and ensure a smooth flow in sewers Water leakages should be attempted promptly to avoid contamination.

6. Before dispatching the tankers from the filling point, required quantity of

residual chlorine should be ensured.

7. Water tankers should be washed and disinfected atleast twice a week.

8. Survey should be conducted for identification of on line booster and a drive is

required to be launched for its removal.

9. All the shallow hand pumps should be painted in red colour and board should be displayed nearer to it that "WATER IS NOT FIT FOR DRINKING PURPOSES".

10. The joint water sampling in the areas prone for contamination should be carried out along with the staff of health Deptt. M.C.D. and D.J.B. Lab.

11.EEs/ZEs should remain in regular touch with respective Zonal D.H.O./M.C.D. for the better coordination to deal with cases of contamination, cholera, Jaundice and gastroenteritis.
