INSTRUCTIONAL ORDER

DATED 20.01.2005
24.01.2005

Instructional orders regarding eligibility criteria for issues of tenders to the contractors registered in various categories of Delhi Jal Board and in various other Govt. departments were issued on 17.09.03. The said order was subsequently modified vide instructional orders dt. 23.10.03, 13.07.04 & 08.10.04 with due consideration of changes made by CPWD. The Delhi Jal Board contractors welfare association has also represented for enforcing the decision already taken by the Addl. Commissioner (W) on dt.20.09.94 regarding issue of tender to the contractors registered with the department.

Keeping in view of enhancement of tendering limit of class I contractors from Rs.5 crores to Rs.10 crores in line with CPWD by the office memorandum issued by the office of CEO-DJB dt.13.01.05, changes from pre-qualification to post qualification as well as two bid tendering system and the representation of the Delhi Jal Board contractors welfare association, the instructional orders are summed up for compliance as under.

Criteria for issue of tenders: -

1. **For Works costing up to Rs.40 Lacs:** - Tenders will be issued to contractors registered with Delhi Jal Board in appropriate category.
2. **For Works costing above Rs.40 Lacs and up to Rs. 100 Lacs:** - Tenders will be issued to: -
 - a) The contractors registered with Delhi Jal Board in appropriate category unless the work is of specialized nature like setting up of water treatment plant, sewage treatment plant, sewage pumping station, water reservoirs and booster pumping stations.
 - b) The contractors registered in appropriate category with CPWD, NDMC and DDA shall also be eligible subject to the conditions that such contractors must have satisfactorily executed three similar nature works each of value not less than 40% of estimated cost or two similar nature works each of value not less than 50% of estimated cost or one similar nature work of value not less than 80% of estimated cost (rounded off to nearest Rs.10 Lacs) in the last 7 years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which the tenders are invited.
3. **For works costing above Rs. 1 crore and up to Rs.10 crores:** - Tenders will be issued to: -
 - a) The contractors registered with Delhi Jal Board in appropriate category unless the work is of specialized nature like setting up of water treatment plant, sewage treatment plant, sewage pumping station, water reservoirs and booster pumping stations.
 - b) The contractors registered in appropriate category with CPWD, NDMC, DDA, State PWDs (Public Health) and State water supply & sewage boards shall also be eligible subject to the conditions that such contractors must have satisfactorily executed three similar nature works each of value not less than 40% of estimated cost or two similar nature works each of value not less than 50% of estimated cost or one similar nature work of value not less than 80% of estimated cost (rounded off to nearest Rs.10 Lacs) in the last 7 years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which the tenders are invited. Member (WS)(DR), DJB can order for post qualification of work costing Rs.5 crores to Rs.10 crores.
4. **For works costing above Rs.10 crores:** - Tenders will be issued to the contractors with or without any registration provided they submit proof of having satisfactorily completed, during the last 7 years, two similar nature works each costing not less than equal to 60% of the estimated cost or one similar nature work costing not less than the estimated cost of the work put to tender.

- NOTE:** - (i) The Chief Engineers may consider the eligibility criteria in respect of turnover at the rate of 30% of the amount put to tender as per CPWD manual.
- (ii) The order is applicable for civil works contracts only and does not include execution of works on work order as well as supply orders. The existing orders on above orders and supply orders shall remain in force as per rules and procedures.
- (iii) The tenders for the work of boring & installation of tube wells, redevelopment, installation of deep bore hand pumps, repair of DBHPs, repair/fabrication/denting/painting of trailer tanker, mounted tanker shells may be issued to agencies who carried out such type of works satisfactory in past and are having requisite infrastructure for the same. The procedure for carrying out repair of departmental mounted tankers, tractors and other vehicles etc. be continued to be carried out as per procedure in vogue.
- (iv) The tender for the work/supply to Electrical/Mechanical work may be issued, who are working in DJB/MES & other Govt. departments as per previous practice.
