## INSTRUCTIONAL ORDER

The earlier LO. No. DJB/Mem(WS)/B-3/04/81371 dated 14.06.04 containing the decision of the Committee constituted for selection of materials for various pipe lines to be used for water supply system in Delhi Jal Board, is re-iterated. In the said order, the modalities to be followed was also decided while calling for tenders with different options of pipe materials. These are re-iterated.

The subsequent Instructional Order No. F-/DJB/M(WS)/2004- dated 17.02.2005 was issued to bring about uniformity in the tendering process throughout DJB. It was specifically mentioned that "in case of offer with alternate material is called for, the tenderers shall clearly indicate the rate on which the offer / BOQ has been quoted". These are re-iterated.

It has been noted with concern that in-spite of above clear orders, certain EEs / SEs / CEs are not following above directions. Instances have come to the notice that the NIT approving authorities are not clearly high-lighting the alternative pipe material options particularly when such options are being allowed in the tender. Such wrong practices may vitiate the procedure as well as the tendering process. This must not happen.

It is enjoined that any one deviating from the laid down procedures, shall attract severe action, as per rules. The Chief engineers should issue strict instructions to SEs / FEs for compliance.
