INSTRUCTIONAL ORDER

Like every year, desilting of sewer lines is being done before on-set of monsoon. With the available resources of Recycler, Suction-cum-Jetting Machine and Super Sucker etc., the action plan for desilting to be completed by June, 2014 has been discussed individually with all EEs/SEs/CEs. After detailed deliberations, the Desilting Plan (as enclosed) has been finalized and submitted to Secretary (UD), Govt. of NCT of Delhi for filing in the Hon'ble High Court in a court matter in WP(C) 5368/2012. To make desilting effective, following instructions are issued for strict compliance: -

- 1. Desilting should be done in such a manner that maximum output is achieved. The work of desilting/cleaning of sewer should be started from peripheral sewer and move backward towards internal sewer lines.
- 2. As already directed vide this office Instruction Order No. F-1(7)/M (Dr.)/2014/376-390 dated 19.02.2014, the photographs/ videographs of Recycler/ Suction-cum-Jetting machine should be taken at the time of deployment and submitted as a proof for payment.
- 3. Monthly reports in the format already circulated to all Chief Engineers (Maintenance) vide this office letter No. DJB/Member (Dr./2014//145-151 dated 21.01.2014 should be sent to this office latest by 5th day of subsequent month.
- 4. The length of sewer lines desilted should be marked on GIS Map available with all JEs for integration on GIS by Mapping Cell.

5. The silt should be removed from site immediately and dispose off at identified DJB land so that least inconvenience is caused to the public.
