1. India has applied for financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Delhi Water Supply Improvement Investment Program - Tranche 1**. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the Contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of the ADB.

2. The **Delhi Jal Board** (the “Employer”), represented by the Project Manager, DWSIIP, invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the *Distribution Network Improvement in UGR Command Areas of CD Park, Fruit Market, Model Town and Mukherjee Nagar*. The detailed scope of work is provided in Section 6, Employers Requirement. The scope of work also includes operating and maintaining the system for a period of 10 years post construction.

3. Only eligible bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:

Financial requirement for current contract commitments	INR 214 Million or its equivalent
One (1) contract comprising civil works in water sector that has been successfully or substantially completed within the last ten (10) years	INR 1350 Million or its equivalent
One (1) contract during last ten (10) years that has been successfully completed including supply, delivery, laying, jointing, testing and commissioning.	2.8 Km of pressure pipes of minimum 1000 mm dia for potable water supply of material type ductile iron or mild steel

Criteria	Requirements
One contract during last 10 years that have been successfully completed including Design, Construction and Commissioning of New Underground Reservoir	Minimum capacity of 10.0 million liters.
One contract during last 10 years that have been successfully completed including Design, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of Raw or Potable water pumping station	Minimum Total capacity of 500KW of which at least one pump of capacity not less than 150KW
Experience in Construction and Commissioning of trenchless technology works for minimum of 1.0 kms within last 10 years in a single or multiple contract	At least 1 contract shall include minimum of 1000 mm diameter of carrier pipe in single stretch of 60 meters

4. **International Competitive Bidding** will be conducted in accordance with ADB's [Single-Stage: Two-Envelope](#) bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.

The Financial Bids of only Technically Responsive and Qualified Bidders shall be opened after Technical Bid Evaluation, whereas, the Financial Bids of those Bidders whose Technical Bids are not responsive and qualified shall be returned unopened after the contract is awarded.
