- India has applied for financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Delhi
 Water Supply Improvement Investment Program. Part of this financing will be used for payments
 under the Contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of the
 ADB.
- 2. The Delhi Jal Board (The Employer), represented by the Project Manager, DWSIIP, invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the Design, Construction, Operation and Maintenance of Distribution Network improvements for NRW reduction and continuous pressurized water supply in UGR command areas of CD Park, Fruit Market, Model Town and Mukherjee Nagar. The detailed scope of work is provided in Section 6, Employers Requirement. The scope of work also includes operating and maintaining the system for a period of 10 years post construction.
